Every year we serve thousands of local children and families, most of whom come from economically challenged backgrounds, marginalized communities, and/or are struggling to maintain safe living conditions for their families. OUR IMPACT: THEN & NOW

httc opened in 2001 when our founder began to share gently used baby and children's items with families in need without charge. She was inspired to address local poverty and established HTC. Then, HTC distributed **2,898** items to **2** partner agencies.

Today, HTC has a *14,400* square foot warehouse and distributes more than *400,000* items annually through *76* direct-service partners in *6* Ohio counties (Butler, Greene, Hamilton, Montgomery, Preble, and Warren). We continue to combat poverty in southwest Ohio by providing basic items to children in need, allowing their caregivers to redirect limited resources to essential living expenses.

Warehouse duties are supervised by over **90** core volunteers who gave over **25,000** hours in 2022. In 2022, our team served approximately **7,200** children in need across all of our programs.

OUR IMPACT

FAMILIES we serve work with partners to identify needs and request specific items via a form our volunteers use to assemble care packages — and provides additional insight into a family's situation..

Family moved here as refugees from the Ukraine. Mom speaks limited English. Dad speaks no English at all.

This request is to support a biological mother and her children that recently encountered a house fire. The family has been linked with The American red cross and given three days to stay at a local hotel. The Agency is working with this family to assist with providing additional supports and services in the future to help with stability. In the meantime, this mother is in desperate need of clothing for these children. If this request is fulfilled and we can support this mother, it would potentially prevent these Sinclair

Destiny is a first time mother who is excited to start her motherhood journey. She has recently been accepted to Sinclair Community College for an Associate's in Education. Destiny is a teacher's aide right now, but her goal is to become a teacher and get her Bachelor's in Education.

FOB is an Army veteran who is currently enrolled in school full-time. He hopes to join the Air Force upon completion of school. Mom is currently working 30 hours a week at the USPS to meet the family's expenses. Their first child was a micro-premie born at 25 weeks. Now, at age 4, she is bright and inquisitive. Parents are excited to welcome their second daughter in just a few short weeks!

This is great grandmother raising the 3 children in this home. She took a leave of absence while getting the children settled so finances are tight for family at this time. She is working again. May also be gaining custody of a fourth grandchild.

The family have come to this country due to persecution and death Concerns! They recently had a baby porn with very complex needs. Of their lives. Father is working. Mother is on extended leave in appreciative hard-working couple.

OUR CURRENT FACILITY




SINCE 2006, Hannah's Treasure Chest has occupied its current facility at 124 Westpark Road in Centerville, Ohio.

In the beginning, HTC operated out of **4,000** square feet.

We expanded to **6,000** square feet in 2007, **8,000** square feet in 2009, **11,200** square feet in 2016.

In 2021, with opening of our charity thrift store, Shop Hannah's, HTC made the final expansion within its current warehouse to occupy 100% of the building at **14,400** square feet.

THERE IS NO ROOM FOR FURTHER DEVELOPMENT AND A NEW FACILITY IS NEEDED TO KEEP PACE WITH THE GROWING NEED IN SOUTHWEST OHIO.



OUR CURRENT FACILITY

HTC is operating at capacity within our current facility.

Each program within Hannah's Treasure Chest has experienced a surge in requests. We must again expand our square footage to meet this need. Additional space will be crucial to serving the increasing number of children in the community experiencing poverty.


Our primary program, the **Care Package Program**, has experienced a **64%** increase in requests from families in need.

The HTC Diaper Bank distributed 77.108 more diapers in 2022, for a total of 260,000 diapers.

The Giving Angels Program saw a 60% increase since 2020.

Most significantly, since 2020, we have witnessed a staggering 472% increase in our Beds for Babies Program.

A NEW BUILDING OPPORTUNITY

HTC's Board of Directors has implemented our first-ever capital campaign.
This \$2 MILLION FUNDRAISING EFFORT will focus on several critical needs Hannah's Treasure Chest must address in the coming years:

FACILITY INVESTMENT

Hannah's Treasure Chest plans on relocating to a new space at 2490 Technical Dr. in Miamisburg. This **35,000*** square foot facility will provide the much-needed additional space for program staff, volunteers, and partners. As our partner rolls increase, relocation to this property will place Hannah's Treasure Chest in an ideal position for ease of access, while greatly increasing our visibility.

LONG-TERM FINANCIAL STABILITY

Hannah's Treasure Chest's call to do more for youth and families in Southwest Ohio is urgent. By putting down roots—with room to grow— we can provide for those most in need.

We will invest in the long-term financial sustainability and flexibility needed to grow our services through the creation of an endowment fund. This campaign will bring Hannah's Treasure Chest to the next level of operational, programmatic, and financial maturity to advance the mission more effectively in the future.




